Jeff: I am recommending that the City Council adopt by reference the International Code Council (ICC) Building Valuation Data (BVD) for the purpose of remaining competitive and equitable in building permit fees. The BVD is updated at sixmonth intervals, with the next update in February 2019. Newnan, for instance, adopted such years ago and has successfully been using it since (see

http://www.cityofnewnan.org/document center/Building Permit Fee Guidelines.pdf). Other cities that have adopted such include:

AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOGANSVILLE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY; TO PROVIDE THAT BUILDING PERMIT VALUATION SHALL BE CALCULATED BASED ON DATA PUBLISHED BY THE INTERNATIONAL CODE COUNCIL; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO FIX AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOGANSVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1:

That Section 102-91 of the Code of the City of Hogansville be amended by deleting said section, in its entirety, inserting in lieu thereof a new Section 102-91 to read as follows:

"Sec. 102-91. - Building Permit Required; fees.

- (a) No building or other structure shall be located, erected, moved, added to, or structurally altered without a building permit issued by the city. No building permit shall be issued except in conformity with the provisions of this chapter.
- (b) A fee for each building permit issued pursuant to the provisions of this chapter shall be paid as required at the time of the filing of the application in accordance with the current fee structure as adopted by the mayor and council.
- (c) For the purposes of building permit valuations, construction valuations shall be determined by the size and type of the building or structure by reference to the Building Valuation Data as established from time-to-time by the International Code Council."

SECTION 2:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3:

This ordinance, after adoption by the Council and upon approval by the Mayor, shall become effective immediately.
