AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOGANSVILLE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY; TO AMEND THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ORDINANCE IN ORDER TO ALLOWS FOR THE PACKAGE SALE OF SEALED GROWLERS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO FIX AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOGANSVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS

SECTION 1:

That Section 6-1 of the Alcoholic Beverages Code of the City of Hogansville be amended by including therein, in proper alphabetical order, the following defined term:

"Growler" shall mean a bottle not to exceed seventy-two (72) ounces that is capable of being sealed with a screw cap and with a plastic collar over the screw cap and is filled with beer or wine from a licensed establishment authorized to sale beer or wine for off-premises consumption."

SECTION 2:

That Section 6-52 of the Alcoholic Beverage Code of the City of Hogansville be amended by deleting said section, in its entirety, inserting in lieu thereof, the following Section 6-52 to read as follows:

"Sec. 6-52. - Retail package licenses.

- (a) Retail package sales of distilled spirits are prohibited in Hogansville. Applicants may apply for one or more of the following type retail package licenses:
 - (1) Package malt beverage license. Retail sale of malt beverages in the original package or in sealed growlers.
 - (2) Package wine license. Retail sale of wine in the original package or in sealed growlers.
- (b) All applications shall be accompanied by an application fee in such amount as may be approved by resolution of the mayor and council from time to time."

SECTION 3:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4:
