

Work Session Meeting

Call to Order: Mayor Jake Ayers called the Work Session to order at 5:37 pm. Present were Mayor Jake Ayers, Council Member Michael Taylor, Council Member Matthew Morgan, Council Member Mandy Neese, Council Member Mark Ayers, and Council Member Toni Striblin. Also present were City Manager Lisa Kelly, Assistant City Manager Niles Ford, City Attorney Alex Dixon, Police Chief Jeff Sheppard, and City Clerk LeAnn Lehigh.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Isaiah Lofton Park Pavers Project Kick-Off

Assistant City Manager Niles Ford has worked hard to prepare the brick pavers for Isaiah Lofton Park. He has worked closely with Dr. Lowe to get the original pavers installed. He explained that he contacted a few engraving companies and Columbus Engraving was by far the most affordable option. They will engrave the bricks for \$23 per brick if we provide the bricks and \$25 if we use their bricks. The City would charge \$30 per brick and will post flyers to social media and constant contact with the information to apply for a paver. They want to make sure that names promoting a person or ideal that isn't in conflict with the park aren't approved. City staff recommends putting together a small committee to oversee the applications for paver names. It would not be an official "City Committee". Council would like to see a "Memory Book" of the brick names with their information.

2. Construction Management Bid Award - Annex Building

The Annex Building Construction Management Bid Award was tabled at the last meeting because Council requested a breakdown of the fees. Brent and Joseph with Principle Construction were there to answer questions. Council agreed that the breakdown of the fees was very helpful. City Manager Lisa Kelly explained that she was mistaken at the last meeting and the bid did include the flooring and painting the entire interior, except for the storage closet. The item is on the Regular Meeting agenda for a vote tonight.

3. Added: CDBG '24

This item is on the Regular Meeting agenda for tonight. Staff is asking the Council to authorize Allen Smith Consulting to apply for the CDBG '24 grant, using funds in SPLOST for the match of \$563K. Staff is proposing using the matching funds out of SPLOST Water/Sewer & Equipment in the amount of \$220,461 for the Carden Street sewer line replacement and using SPLOST Road, Sidewalks & Equipment funds of \$342,539 to match funds for the Village area stormflow drains.



BY GEORGIA ENVIRONMENTAL FINANCE A	UTHORITY, a Georgia public corporation
(the "Lender").	

Statement of Facts

- A. The Lender and the Borrower are parties to that certain Loan Agreement, dated **DECEMBER 20, 2022**, as amended prior to the date hereof (as so amended, the "Loan Agreement"; all capitalized terms used in this Modification but not defined herein have the meanings given in the Loan Agreement), pursuant to which the Lender made a loan to the Borrower in accordance with the terms and conditions thereof. The Borrower's obligation to repay such loan is evidenced by that certain Promissory Note, dated **SEPTEMBER 30, 2022**, as amended prior to the date hereof (as so amended, the "Note").
- B. The Lender and the Borrower desire to modify the Loan Agreement and Note in certain respects in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein.
- **NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the promises, the covenants and agreements contained herein, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, the Lender and the Borrower further agree as follows:

Statement of Terms

1. <u>Amendments of Note</u> - Subject to the fulfillment of the conditions precedent to the effectiveness of this Modification that are set forth below, the Note is hereby amended as follows:

Accrued interest on this Note shall be payable monthly on the first day of each calendar month until the first day of the calendar month following the earlier of (1) the Completion Date (as defined in the hereinafter defined Loan Agreement), (2) **DECEMBER 1, 2025**, or (3) the date that the loan evidenced by this Note is fully disbursed (the "Amortization Commencement Date"). Principal of and interest on this Note shall be payable in TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE (239) consecutive monthly installments equal to the Installment Amount (as hereinafter defined), commencing on the first day of the calendar month following the Amortization Commencement Date, and continuing to be due on the first day of each succeeding calendar month thereafter, together with a final installment equal to the entire remaining unpaid principal balance of and all accrued interest on this Note, which shall be due and payable on the date that is 20 years from the Amortization Commencement Date (the "Maturity Date").

2. <u>Amendments of Loan Agreement</u> - Subject to the fulfillment of the conditions precedent to the effectiveness of this Modification that are set forth below, the Loan Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2 (a) of the Loan Agreement is hereby amended and restated to read as follows: "The Lender agrees to advance to the Borrower, on or prior to the earlier of (1) the Completion Date (as hereinafter defined), (2) **DECEMBER 1, 2025**, or (3) the date that the loan evidenced by this Note is fully disbursed, the Loan in a principal amount of up to \$2,934,000 which Loan may be disbursed in one or more advances but each such disbursement shall reduce the Lender's loan commitment hereunder and any sums advanced hereunder may not be repaid and then re-borrowed."

Exhibit A is amended and restated to read as written in the attached Exhibit A.

- 3. <u>No Other Waivers or Amendments</u> Except for the amendments expressly set forth and referred to in Section 1 and 2 above, the Note and the Loan Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect. Nothing in this Modification is intended, or shall be construed, to constitute a novation or an accord and satisfaction of any of the obligations created by the Note.
- 4. Representations and Warranties To induce the Lender to enter into this Modification, the Borrower does hereby warrant, represent, and covenant to the Lender that: (a) each representation or warranty of the Borrower set forth in the Loan Agreement is hereby restated and reaffirmed as true and correct on and as of the date hereof as if such representation or warranty were made on and as of the date hereof (except to the extent that any such representation or warranty expressly relates to a prior specific date or period), and no Event of Default has occurred and is continuing as of this date under the Loan Agreement; and (b) the Borrower has the power and is duly authorized to enter into, deliver, and perform this Modification, and this Modification is the legal, valid, and binding obligation of the Borrower enforceable against it in accordance with its terms.
- 5. <u>Conditions Precedent to Effectiveness of this Modification</u> The effectiveness of this Modification is subject to the truth and accuracy in all material respects of the representations and warranties of the Borrower contained in Section 4 above and to the fulfillment of the following additional conditions precedent:
- a. the Lender shall have received one or more counterparts of this Modification duly executed and delivered by the Borrower; and
- b. the Lender shall have received (1) a signed opinion of counsel to the Borrower, substantially in the form of Exhibit E attached hereto, and (2) a certified copy of the resolution adopted by the Borrower's governing body, substantially in the form of Exhibit F attached hereto.
- **6.** <u>Counterparts</u> This Modification may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original and all of which when taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
