Mayor Jake Ayers called the Public Hearing to Order at 10:02 am to hear citizen comments on the adoption of the Millage Rate.

Also present were Assistant City Manager Niles Ford, City Attorney Alex Dixon, and City Clerk LeAnn Lehigh. Assistant City Manager Niles Ford gave a PowerPoint presentation on the Millage Rate. He explained that the millage rate has remained the same for the past 19 years at 7.950 mills, and would remain the same this year.
