PRESENTATION

1. Charon Prophet – Elevations Youth Center

Charon Prophet addressed the Council about the Elevations of 5 Cs of Prophet Youth Center located at Hogansville Elementary School. He said that the after-school program has helped kids bring up their grades and helps with social skills. They will have a 5-week summer program this year for ages 5-14 and will have the older kids mentoring and tutoring the younger kids. The City budgets funds for the program each year and he would like the program to continue receiving the funding.
