Motion: A motion was made by Council Member Neese to authorize Allen Smith Consulting to apply for the CDBG '24 grant, using funds in SPLOST for the match of \$563K, using the matching funds out of SPLOST Water/Sewer & Equipment in the amount of \$220,461 for the Carden Street sewer line replacement and using SPLOST Road, Sidewalks & Equipment funds of \$342,539 to match funds for the Village area stormflow drains.
